Health Center Doctor Receives Distinction

AMSTERDAM – Dr. Jun Lei, MD a Primary Care Physician at Liberty’s Health Center, New Dimensions in Health Care (NDHC), has received recognition from the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) Diabetes Recognition Program for providing quality care to his patients with diabetes.

The Diabetes Recognition Program (DPRP) was designed to improve the quality of care that patients with diabetes receive by recognizing clinicians who deliver quality diabetes care, and by motivating other clinicians to document and improve their delivery of diabetes care. The DPRP recognition is valid for three years and was granted based on information Dr. Lei supplied regarding his approach to diabetes prevention and care.

“While upholding the ongoing high-quality of care New Dimensions in Health Care offers, it is my personal mission to ensure that patients with diabetes receive the care they deserve,” said Dr. Lei. “Diabetes is a disease that can kill yet is manageable with the right support system in place. We strive to provide top-quality patient-centered primary care to those who walk through our door, and now those suffering from diabetes have a place to go.”
