WHO

is Eligible to Vote?

If **YOU** say yes to the following,
YOU are eligible to vote!

Are you a United States citizen?

Will you be **18 years old** by December 31 of the year in which you file a voter registration form (note: you must be 18 years old by the date of the general, primary or other election in which you want to vote)?

Have you **lived** at your present address at least 30 days before an election?

(If you claim the right to vote elsewhere or are on parole for a felony conviction or in jail, you are not eligible to vote.)

How do I register to vote?

New York requires eligible and interested individuals to vote to complete a New York State Voter Registration Form. There are a few ways to obtain the form:

Complete the Voter Registration Form online on the NYS Department of Motor Vehicles website here: dmv.ny.gov/more-info/electronic-voter-registration-application - Note: You must have a valid New York State driver's license or ID to use this website.

Complete the fillable form online at www.elections.ny.gov/

Call 1-800-FOR-VOTE to request a voter registration form

Visit your county Board of Elections office (address search here: www.elections.ny.gov/CountyBoards.html) to obtain a voter registration form and submit the form while you're there

Visit any New York State agency-based voter registration center (for locations go to www.elections.ny.gov/NVRA.html). Locations include OPWDD, OMH, OASAS, DOL
